

## **Rainbow Ark Preschool Application**

- \* *Rainbow Ark Preschool is a ministry of Antioch Christian Church, Washington, IN.*
- \* *Rainbow Ark runs September through May and follows the Washington Community School calendar.*
- \* *Preschool begins Tuesday, Sept. 6th (3-4 year olds) & Wednesday Sept. 7th (4-5 year olds).*
- \* *Students enrolling in our preschool program need to be toilet trained.*

### **Rainbow Ark currently has four classes to offer:**

The **AM Pre-K** (4-5 year olds) class meets on **Tuesday/ Thursday from 8:30am to 11:00am**

To enroll in this class children must be 4 years old by Aug 1<sup>st</sup>, 2011 . The first day of school will be on Wednesday, September 7th. On August 23rd from 6-8 pm, there will be a “Meet the Teacher” open house for the morning 4-5 year old class.

The **PM Pre-K** (4-5 year olds) class meets on **Monday/Wednesday from 12:30 to 3:00 PM.**

To enroll in this class children must be 4 years old by Aug 1<sup>st</sup>, 2011. The first day of school will be on Wednesday, September 7th. On August 16th from 6-8pm, there will be a “Meet the Teacher” open house for the afternoon 4-5 year old class.

The **Little Lions Class** (3-4 year olds) meets on **Monday/ Wednesday from 8:30-11:00AM.**

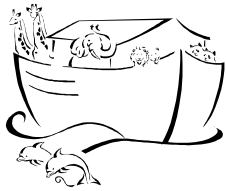
To enroll in this class children must be 3 years old by Aug 1<sup>st</sup>, 2011. The first day of school will be on Tuesday, September 7th . On August 23rd from 6-8pm, there will be a “Meet the Teacher” open house for the 3-4 year old classes.

The **Leapin’ Lizards Class** (3-4 year olds) meets on **Tuesday/ Thursday from 8:30-11:00AM.**

To enroll in this class children must be 3 years old by Aug 1<sup>st</sup>, 2011. The first day of school will be on Tuesday, September 7th . On August 23rd from 6-8pm there will be a “Meet the Teacher” open house for the 3-4 year old classes.

- \* *A \$5 (non-refundable) processing and placement fee is required at the time of enrollment. This fee covers application processing and holds a spot in our class for your child.*
- \* *Rainbow Ark Preschool participates in the Voucher Assistance Program. For more information on the voucher program see attached information.*

- \* *Classes meeting three days a week cost \$70 monthly.*

# Voucher Assistance Program Information

## WHO ARE ELIGIBLE CCDF VOUCHER FAMILIES?

Just as providers must meet certain criteria to become eligible for the CCDF voucher program, so must families who want to enroll in the CCDF program.

### SERVICE NEED

Generally speaking, parent(s) must be employed or in school. TANF Impact families need to obtain a referral from their caseworker. The number of hours approved for child care depends on the work/school schedule of the parent(s). Parents may also be on Job Search for a limited amount of time.

### FINANCIAL NEED

Effective 10/1/2002\*, a new applicant must have gross monthly family income less than 127% of the Federal Poverty Level to be enrolled in the program. Effective 9/30/2007\*, families may remain on the CCDF program as long as the family's Federal Poverty Level (gross\*\* income) is less than 171%.

Gross income does include child support as well as certain other benefits. Food Stamps do not count as gross income.

\* Official notice would be given from the state if these guidelines change in the future.

\*\*Gross income means income before taxes are taken out.

RESIDENCY Families must apply for CCDF at the Local Intake Office in the county in which they live, even if their child care provider is located in a different county.

### AGE OF CHILD

Children must be *under* age 13, unless they have a *documented* special need waiver. Children with documented special needs may be enrolled up *through* age 17.

ELIGIBLE  
PROVIDER

Families wishing to enroll and maintain their eligibility *must* choose a child care provider(s) who meets CCDF Provider Eligibility Standards.

Failing to keep their children enrolled with an authorized provider could result in removing the family from the CCDF program.

Parents are required to recertify their eligibility *at least* every six months at the Local Intake Office. Parents are required to report any changes in the chart shown above to the Local Intake Office *immediately*.

**Alert: Failure of the parent to report any of these changes to the local Intake Office could result in demand for repayment of services from the family.**
