**Small Group Discussion Questions:**

1. What does freedom mean to most people and how does their notion of freedom affect their lives?
2. From the standpoint of the United States and our society, why are restraints important if freedom is to be protected? How can “freedom” be abused?
3. Read all of Leviticus 25. Discuss this command and all the social, economic and cultural implications of it.
4. Read John 8:31-41. What does Jesus say about freedom? In what ways had the Jewish leaders deceived themselves?
5. In what ways does Jesus offer freedom?
6. Discuss the warnings of 1 Corinthians 8:9, Galatians 5:13 and 1 Peter 2:16, and what they mean in your life and the life of your church.
7. Read 1 Corinthians 6:12. How do you need to be more disciplined in your life to keep yourself from being enslaved?
8. How do you need to become more disciplined in your spiritual walk? (Example, Bible study, prayer, quiet time.)
9. How can small groups help in this area of Christian discipline?
