

Small Group Discussion Questions:

1. Discuss what you feel is the purpose of Gods “team” (the Church). What does He accomplish through the Church?

2. Before reading this week’s scripture, take the following “True/False” test:
 T or F? The more important the spiritual gift, the more mature and spiritual the person.
 T or F? We must ask God for the spiritual gift we want.
 T or F? Some Christians have little to contribute to others.
 T or F? Some people are more important than others in the church as in every other situation.

3. Now, read 1 Corinthians 12-14. Then, revisit the “True/False” questions above and discuss them within your group.

4. Read 1 Corinthians 1:4-7. How many of the spiritual gifts does Paul say the church in Corinth was missing? (Hint: Look in verse 7.) Do you think this applies to your church?

5. Read the following passages and make a list of as many spiritual gifts as you find. Discuss the meaning of each one. (You may want to look at other translations for help with this.) How is each used to build up the Body of Christ? 1 Corinthians 12:8-10, 28; Romans 12:6-8; Ephesians 4:11; 1 Peter 4:9-10.

6. Read 1 Corinthians 13:1-3. Have you ever found yourself feeling empty, even though you actively serve in church? What does this passage say may be the reason for this empty feeling?

7. 1st John 4:7-21 is a great passage for a discussion of God’s love and how it should be expressed in our lives. Read this passage with your group and discuss those verses which catch your attention.

8. If you do not know what your spiritual gifts are, or if it has been several years since you evaluated this, will you commit to taking the spiritual gifts class during the first session of WNL this fall?
